The district is entirely an agricultural one, subdivided into small farms—the products being, in addition to cereals and root crops, oranges, grapes, and tobacco; the land is alluvial and rich, but subject to disastrous floods. This district is also noted for the excellence of breed of horses and cattle. The surrounding country is extremely mountainous, but there are extensive flats to the south and west. The geological formation is sandstone and shale. There is splendid freestone to be obtained here for building purposes; and within easy distance of navigation are extensive beds of limestone. Coal exists about two miles distant.
